Year of Report 2008-2009

Part A

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and the outcome achieved by the end of the year.

NAAC peer team evaluated institution on the 18th April and 19th April 2008. Institute got the evaluation report and guidance by the NAAC. After receiving the report, coordinator Dr. V. S. Patil organized the meeting under the chairmanship of the principal. All teachers and non-teaching staff participated. The evaluation and observation done by the team was discussed in the meeting. In this meeting institutions strengths and weaknesses were focused. The NAAC committee has given recommendations for the quality enhancement of the institutions. They were as following.

Recommendations for Quality Enhancement of the Institution.

1. The faculty may be encouraged to acquire qualifications as per NCTE and UGC norms.
2. The mathematics lab may be established and science laboratory and library may be strengthened.
3. English communication skill may be developed.
4. The students should be trained in models of teaching.
5. For the quality teaching smaller groups may be formed for teaching the core papers.
6. The curriculum should be revised keeping in view the NCTE as well as UGC curriculum framework and ICT should be independent paper.
7. Regular workshops for faculty improvement related to innovative methods of teaching, models of teaching. Evaluation Research methodology, statistics and use of SPSS different uses of ICT etc may be organized.
8. Quality digitized instructional material may be developed for wider use.
9. One hour per week exercises in reasoning and thinking may be given to students.
10. Potential of Alumni Association may be utilized for quality improvement by organizing more interactive sessions and College should organize short duration workshop for the Alumni in areas like wise of ICT. Teaching concepts writing questions for open book examination.
11. The faculty members may be encouraged to publish papers in Journals of repute.

Regarding the above recommendations what can be done for the quality enhancement. The discussion was on this question. It was decided that action plan is necessary for the quality enhancement. To complete the following committee was formed.

The above said committee planned the activities properly. All the teaching and non-teaching staff worked and planned various activities in order to enhance the quality of the institution.

It was decided to take the help of the Alumni students, parents, head of the institution and experienced teachers for the quality improvement.

Action plan was decided carefully and the work was distributed according to the recommendations suggested by NAAC peer team. To wash out the weaknesses of institution, an action oriented plan was prepared. This plan was implemented for the whole academic year 2008-09. At the end of the academic year a review was taken to check the success we have achieved in this academic year through this programme.

Following were the weaknesses observed by NAAC peer team during their visit to the institution.

1. The college has yet to develop need based enrichment programme.
2. No formal feed-back is obtained from parents.
3. The college needs to provide training in the models of teaching.
4. Most of the teachers do not possess qualification as per UGC and NCTE norms.
5. The faculty may be motivated to acquire qualification as prescribed by NCTE and UGC.
6. Institution is yet to develop expertise to provide consultancy services.
7. The college needs to develop more need based extension programmes
8. The college has yet to develop collaborations with other organizations.

9. More space for the students to seat and read in the library be provided.
10. The college is yet to develop best practices related to infrastructure and learning resources.
11. The college does not have the placement cell. Yet student are helped in placement.
12. The leadership needs to be strengthened.
13. There is no formal grievance redressal cell yet the matters stilled and amicably.
14. The college needs to appoint qualified full time faculty.
15. Self appriaisal evaluation needs to be finalised.
16. Office automation is yet to be made.
17. No research publications are undertaken.
18. Utilization of modern teaching techniques by the teacher need to be strengthened.
19. The college can make better use of ICT for teaching and learning.
20. Developing collaboration with national institutions of repute.

2. New academic programme initiated (U.G. and P.G.)

The newly D.S.M. course was introduced by the institution.

The name of the course is “Diploma in School Management”. The affiliation University – Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nasik. No. of seats are 60 during the year 2008-09. 54 students were admitted. All the students successfully completed the course. There was 100% result of this course.

The students admitted for this course were Head Masters of the schools, Supervisor of the schools, Vice-principal and Assistant Head Masters and experienced teachers and the persons having degrees and serving at the same time were admitted for this course. To serve in Education department it was made compulsory to pass the said course. There was a heavy rush for admission to this course. The D.S.M. course work is recognized as an extension course by National Assessment and Accreditation Council Bangalore.
